



Blue Elf *Sedeveria*

- **Blue-green** rosette of flattened, upright leaves that blush orange and pink at their tips
- **Soft, matte finish** from a powdery coating of epicuticular wax (farina) that protects the foliage in full sun
- **Nicknamed “Happy Plant”** because it produces cheery, yellow flowers multiple times a year
- **Low maintenance grower** that stays under about 4” in diameter and produces lots of new offsets around its base

Zone: 10 (30°F)

Olivia *Graptoveria*

- **Olive green** rosette with rosy pink leaf tips and a bronze sheen when grown in bright sun
- **Can bloom repeatedly** with pale yellow flowers on tall bloom stalks
- **Thrives on sunny windowsills** or outside in partial sun when there’s no chance of frost; use gritty, well-draining pots and soil
- **Low, open rosette** that develops lots of densely-packed leaves and does not grow a tall, bare stem

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Purple Delight *Graptopetalum*

- **Delightfully splotchy** pink to lilac leaves show vibrant pigments when grown in full sun
- **Classic stemmed rosette** with elegant, slightly cupped foliage whorled around tall stems
- **Powdery coating of farina** (natural wax) protects it in full sun and droughts and gives a matte finish
- **Fast grower** that can spill out of containers but also takes well to regular pruning and re-rooting

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Emerald Ripple *Echeveria*

- **Shiny, apple green** leaves are tightly packed together in a low, cupped rosette that can reach 5” wide
- **Stress coloring from drought** and direct sun presents as an orange to red blush at the leaf tips
- **Produces lots of offsets** around its base, eventually developing into a tidy clump; simple to propagate from offsets or leaves
- **Thrives in dry, sunny conditions**, so plant in well-draining pots / soil and keep outdoors or on a sunny window sill

Graptopoveria

- **Pink, lilac, and peach tones** with the most vibrant pigments appearing when grown outdoors or under a grow light
- **Low, open rosette** of long, slender leaves that can reach about 8" in diameter at maturity
- **Tolerates full sun** once established in part due to a thick covering of natural, powdery wax
- **Easy to grow and propagate** in well-draining pots / soil with deep but infrequent watering

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Murasaki

Graptopoveria

- **Pink to purple rosette** that show its most vibrant pigments when grown outdoors or under a grow light
- **Low, open rosette** of long, chunky leaves that can reach about 5" in diameter at maturity
- **Tolerates full sun** once established in part due to a thick covering of natural, powdery wax
- **Easy to grow and propagate** in well-draining pots / soil with deep but infrequent watering

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
