



Turquoise Tails

Petrosedum sediforme syn.
Sedum sediforme

- **Robust, frost-hardy** stonecrop that tends to have upright stems up to 10" tall
- **Strong, blue-green leaves** are shaped like pine needles and last even through cold, snowy winters
- **Blooms in summer** by sending up tall bloom stalks with creamy, yellow flowers that attract pollinators
- **Thrives outdoors** despite full sun, drought, hard frosts, or shallow, rocky soil and propagates readily from stem cuttings

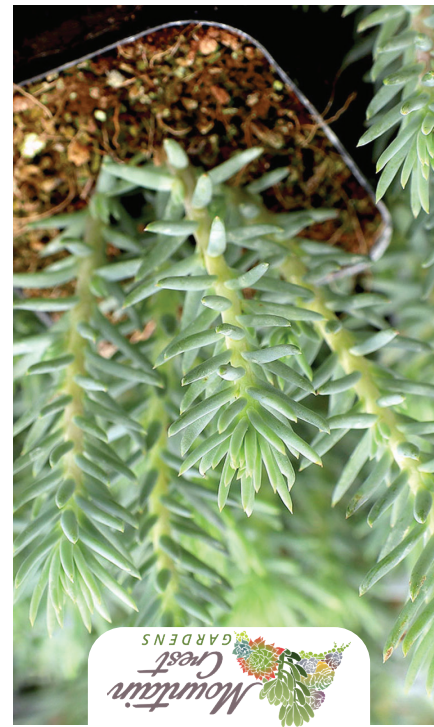
S. dasyphyllum

Sedum dasyphyllum

- **Distinctive blue foliage** can flush lilac in response to moderate stress from full sun or drought
- **Spreads a tight mat** of tiny, bead-like leaves, both in-ground and in containers
- **Frost hardy outdoor plant** down to 0F for sunny, rocky areas of the garden
- **Charming, small, white flowers** bloom in summer and can attract pollinators

Blue Spruce

Petrosedum rupestre syn.
Sedum reflexum

- **Well-loved classic** of the frost-hardy stonecrops that grows well outdoors and looks great year-round
- **Forgiving ground cover** of creeping stems that easily spread or spill from pots, but won't overtake other plants
- **Strong, blue-green leaves** are shaped like pine needles and can flush salmon pink in cold, winter months
- **Thrives outdoors** despite full sun, drought, hard frosts, or shallow, rocky soil

Zone: 4 (-30°F)

Variegatum

Sedum makinoi

- **Eye-catching golden ground cover** native to rocky valleys of three of the main islands of Japan
- **Bright gold to lime colors** and a glossy finish to its small, round leaves make for a distinctive accent plant
- **Easy outdoor plant** that stays under 5" tall and spreads easily without overtaking neighboring plants
- **Frost tolerant down to 0F** when grown in well-draining soil; can tolerate slightly more shade and water than most *Sedum*

Coral Carpet

Sedum album

- **Low, spreading ground cover** that develops into a dense mat of mini, beadlike leaves
- **Turns from green to red** when moderately stressed by full sun, drought, or below-freezing temperatures
- **Blooms midsummer** with tiny, white, star-shaped flowers
- **Tolerates neglect and shallow, rocky soil**; ideal for green roofs and vertical plantings

Zone: 4 (-30°F)

Dragon's Blood

Sedum spurium

- **A robust ground cover** that easily tolerates months of drought, full sun, rocky soil, and frosts down to -30F
- **Red to purple blush** intensifies with the cool nights of spring and fall; loses some leaves in winter and re-sprouts in spring
- **Late summer bloomer** with prolific, red flowers that attract pollinators
- **Easy to grow** in the ground or outdoor containers; can eventually spill out with nice, trailing stems

Zone: 4 (-30°F)
