## Jade Sempervivum heuffelii

- · Develops into a dense cluster of tightly packed rosettes as it propagates through crown division

# **Bronze Pastel** Sempervivum marmoreum

- Metallic sheen highlights seasonal color tones of red, orange, yellow, and green
- Dense rosette of tightly packed leaves with pointed tips and ciliated margins
- British cultivar released in 1953 by poet turned plant hybridizer, Nicholas Moore
- · Plant outdoors in well-draining soil for vibrant colors and spring offsets ("chicks")

# Weihenstaphaner Gold

Sedum kamtschaticum var. floriferum

- Vigorous ground cover that brings lushness to simple, drought-friendly landscaping
- Spreads as long stems covered with broad, green leaves with serrated edges
- Tolerates hard frosts by going dormant and losing leaves, which sprout anew each spring
- · Prolific yellow flowers in summer that make a great food source for pollinators
