

Chocoleto

Sempervivum heuffelii

- **Elegant rosette** of tight leaves that shift between pink, jade green, and lavender tones through the seasons
- **Fringe of cilia** line the foliage and highlight each leaf with bright white “lashes”
- **Super frost hardy** all the way down to -30F (Zone 4) and tolerates full sun and drought
- **Self-propagates** through “crown division” with new offsets emerging from within the mother rosette

Zone: 4 (-20°F)

Sempervivum globiferum ssp. allionii

- **Spiky-looking rosette** of narrow, pointed leaves that close inward to turn the rosette into a ball or “roller”
- **Lime green leaves** lighten to yellow in summer sun then flush burgundy in winter
- **Prolific self-propagator** that produces lots of new offsets that can roll away to re-root
- **Easy rock garden plant** that forms dense mounds, even in full sun, drought, and temps down to -20F

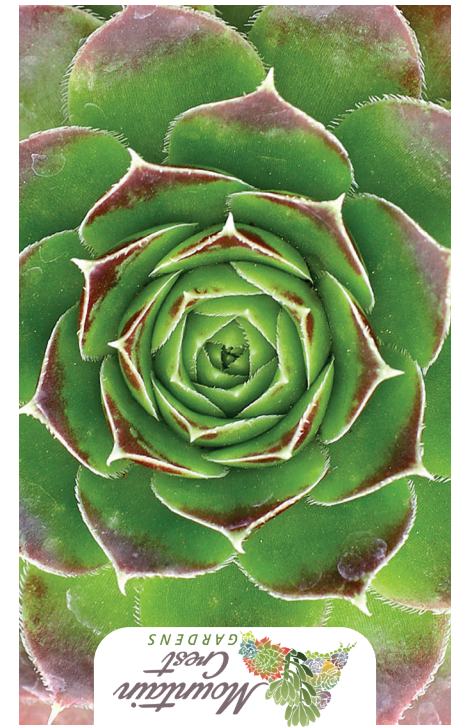
Water Lily

Sempervivum heuffelii

- **One of the larger cultivars** of *S. heuffelii* with extra broad, bright green leaves
- **Resilient grower** that divides each year to form mounded clusters
- **Plant in full, outdoor sun** with well-draining soil to encourage growth
- **Drought tolerant plant** for verdant, waterwise landscaping, even in hot summers and rocky soil

Zone: 4 (-20°F)

Blaze

Sempervivum heuffelii

- **Frost hardy outdoor succulent** for low water, low maintenance gardening
- **Dramatic rosette** that changes color seasonally between red, green, and a near-black purple
- **Bright white edges** outline the leaves and give the plant a crisp look
- **Thrives in full sun** with deep but infrequent water through hot summers

Zone: 4 (-20°F)

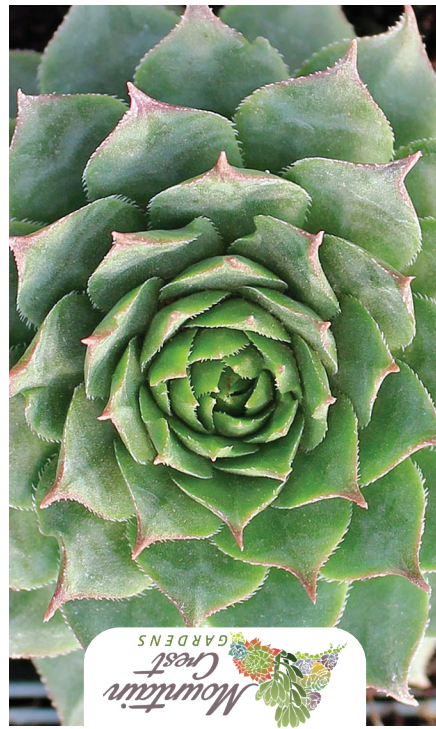


Sempervivum arachnoideum ssp. tomentosum f/ Gorge de Daluis

- Adorable “webbed” rosettes with a natural covering of soft, white wool
- Prolific clumper that produces mats of small, spherical chicks or offsets
- Species native to the Caucasus Mountains where it tolerates extreme frost and drought
- Prefers dry conditions and benefits from a top dressing of gravel to keep leaves off damp soil

Zone: 5 (-30°F)

Kalinda
Sempervivum

- Satin-finish rosette with nice seasonal colors from copper to olive to purple
- Good clumper that produces offsets each year on long stolons to develop a big cluster
- Grows wide with extra long leaves that pull in tightly through winter
- Outdoor succulent that need lots of sun and tolerates drought, rocky soil, and frost down to -20F
