





## Swan Lake Echeveria

- Angluar, pointed leaves curve outward from the center of the rosette and give it a unique, architectural look
- Blushing pastel tones of silver to lilac get a soft matte finish from a powdery coating of natural wax
- Hybrid cultivar (short for "cultivated variety") of Echeveria 'Topsy Turvy' and E. shaviana
- Thrives in bright light, either on a sunny windowsill or outdoors in frost-free weather

# Giant Blue Echeveria

- Large, ruffly rosette of leaves that get wavier at their margins as they mature
- Blue-green base coloration that gets colorful accents of pink and orange in response to sun and drought
- Grow in lot of direct sunshine to keep this
  sun-loving beauty colorful and healthy
- Mature specimens can grow tall on a bare stem, but take well to "beheading" and re-rooting

# Frizzle Sizzle Albuca Spiralis

- Collector's variety of bulb succulent that can be planted high with the top part of the bulb exposed
- Curly, corkscrew leaves sprout in response to autumn rains and die back during a dry, summer dormancy
- Large, yellow flowers bob and nod on a tall bloom stalk and release a rich, vanilla fragrance
- For max curliness, give more sun and less frequent water to model the South African species's native climate

Tarantula


- Spidery, twisting foliage stands upright and can blush red at the tips in bright sunlight
- Showy flower clusters of pink to red can bloom spring or fall and attract pollinators
- Thick, waxy leaves help this plant tolerate drought; water deeply but only when soil is completely dry
- Tall, low maintenance houseplant that can grow into a 12.0" tall bush on a sunny windowsill

# Topsy Turvy Echeveria

- Wavy, angled leaves curve outward from the center of the rosette and give it a distinctive, elegant look
- Pale, pastel tones of silver to light blue get a soft matte finish from a powdery coating of natural wax
- **Stable "sport"** (morphologically distinct form) of the naturally occurring species Echeveria runyonii
- Thrives in bright light, either on a sunny windowsill or outdoors in frost-free weather
